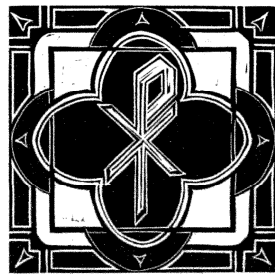

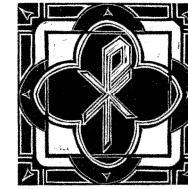


From the first two letters of Christ's name written in Greek,
