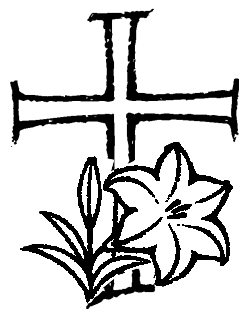

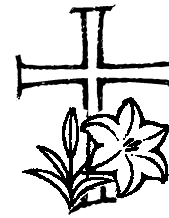
## Announcements
